RCCF Grant Presentations

On behalf of the RCCF Board, Jermaine presented checks to the following grant recipients:

\$3,750 to Rotarian **Bennett Helms** for his desk project that provides personalized desks to students at Fraser participating in the home study environment.

\$3,000 to **Cities in Schools** for their Summer Education Program.

\$3,000 to **Coastal Carolina Boy Scouts** for row boats, life preservers and other boating accessories for their summer camp program.

\$2,500 to **Metanoia** to provide materials for the Financial Literacy program for community students.
