Annual Program Fund (APF) Goal - \$20,000

Achieved as of 12/15/2009 - **\$13,142**

Polio Eradication Club Goal - \$10,000

Achieved as of 12/15/09 - **\$2,150**

We are 50% through the year and we've achieved 51% of our total Rotary Foundation goals. Many Rotarians stepped up and gave the additional \$100 to APF and the \$50 to Polio during the November-December challenge months. And December is not over. Perhaps even more will come in... Carroll or I will gladly help you become part of our success! There are still a few of the \$25 gift certificates left.

**Polio Eradication:**

Rotary International President Canseco officially announced the Polio 2005 program to the Rotary world on 23 February 1985 – Rotary's 80<sup>th</sup> birthday. Rotary's commitment electrified the global health community. Such an undertaking by an NGO was unprecedented in its financial scope and program potential. Rotary teamed with WHO, UNICEF, and the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC):

Of all the partnerships that we developed while I was at the CDC, none has been more impressive than the partnership with Rotary International and other partners working on the Global eradication of polio,” Dr David Satcher, former CDC official and Surgeon General of the United States. There are only 4 countries left – Pakistan, Afghanistan, India and Nigeria. It's a major goal, and we are part of it. Help us with our Club commitment.
