


The cover and an inscription from a Club founder to a member of a year's worth of the Rotary Ragout - - an early version of the Keyway.



Rotary's next century

If one seeks to predict the future by looking to the past, the next 100 years of the Rotary Club of Charleston are bright and filled with promise.

"I feel confident as our Club moves into the next century that the Rotary Club of Charleston will continue to hold on tightly to the Four Way Test in all that we do and say in our personal and business lives," said 2004–05 President Mark Smith. "Our motto, 'Service Above Self' is in the heart and soul of all of our members"

Since the Rotary Club of Charleston got started 85 years ago, thousands of members from all sectors of the business community have put local service above the needs of self.

As noted by past President Ken Johnson, who joined the Club in 1962, "The total membership meshed together and worked together. No one said no to another member. Attendance was high and the spirit was 'positive.' The Four Way Test was taken to heart. Rotary pride prevailed."

Now and in the future, this expectation of excellence in community service remains for members of the Rotary Club of Charleston.

Past President James A. Grimsley said he thought Club members would continue to be a powerful community force. "One of the most refreshing experiences has been the universal respect by our membership throughout the years of adherence to the unwritten Rotary Club rule, 'Never say no.' This has produced not only the accomplishment of numerous requirements and projects, but has generated a positive, 'can do' attitude which permeates our activities. I trust those in charge in the years ahead will ensure that this cardinal tenet remains in force."

It surely will, according to Past President James A. Stuckey who believes members in the future will continue to spark community achievements and accomplishments. "The Club presently has more buildings named in honor of its members to recognize their achievements than any other service club," he said.

"The Rotary Club of Charleston will continue to have the leading business, educational and professional leaders of the community and will foster new ones."

Another past president, Anita Zucker, agreed Club members would continue to have a major impact on Charleston. "Through the Charleston Rotary Fund, we will have the opportunity to continue to help the high school seniors and teachers of Charleston County. My greatest hope is that through our tutoring and reading efforts, we will begin to see a change in the dropout rate of students in our schools. The organization has numerous opportunities to influence the direction of our region through its many members and their businesses and interests."

As the Club continues to serve the Charleston community, past President Anne Moise said it must become even more involved and representative. "Our club will continue to become more diverse," she said. "We will continue to be inclusive with representatives from a widening circle of Charleston businesses with a membership who will become more and more active in the community, both in leadership and volunteer roles."

Past President John Milkereit warned the Club's leaders would have to work hard to keep future business leaders involved because they would be more mobile and have less time for service club commitments. "More effort will have to be dedicated to building and maintaining membership if we are going to continue our service projects and financial commitments to local as well as worthy Rotary International programs."

Rotary has thrived in Charleston because of the dedication of individual members who have given back to the community. But what really makes Rotary tick is the quality of its membership. For the Rotary Club of Charleston to continue to have impact over the next 100 years, its members must continue to be selective of the most outstanding people in Charleston.

Rotary can never become a club for everyone. It can never become a mere social club or just a private club for business people. It must continue to be selective, but also inclusive and diverse. It must be a home for future leaders of the Holy City. Tomorrow's Rotarians in Charleston must to embrace the dedication and commitment of Rotarians from the past 85 years and use their examples as a path to a future of distinguished community service.
